

The Jockey Club Kau Sai Chau Public Golf Course – North Course Wednesday, 9 December 2020

Information for Competitors

1. Venue and Date

Now TV Presents 2020 JCKSC Masters to be played on Wednesday, 9 December 2020 at the Jockey Club Kau Sai Chau Public Golf Course – North Course.

2. Entries / Entry Fee

The entry fee for the tournament is HK\$810 per person.

The entry form can be obtained from JCKSC website: www.kscgolf.org.hk/golf/tournaments/. Simply fill in the entry form and indicate your payment by way of a charge credit card providing detailed information and your authorized signature or by cheque (in Hong Kong Dollar only, crossed and make payable to “The Jockey Club Kau Sai Chau Public Golf Course Limited”), you can fax the entry form to JCKSC at 2792-9612, email to tournament@kscgolf.org.hk or return it to **P.O. Box 88, Sai Kung Post Office, Sai Kung, Hong Kong.** (Attention to: **Tournament Committee**)

A copy of a current handicap certificate or proof of handicap (**issued and updated on or after 9 June 2020**) must be accompanied with each entry form.

Entries closing date: Wednesday, 25 November 2020

The Tournament Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry without giving reasons or disqualify any competitor making a false statement on the entry form. All disputes and matters arising in connection with the Championships shall be referred to the Tournament Committee, whose decision shall be final.

3. Withdrawal Policy

The rules for cancellation are as follows:

- a) Prior to the entries closing date by 6:00 p.m. in writing or fax only – no penalty.
- b) After 6:00 p.m. of the entries closing date in writing or fax only – 50% of the entry fees will be forfeited as administration charge under any circumstances.
- c) Any cancellation during the tournament periods – no refund.

4. Registration

All competitors must register at the Tournament check-in counter in the Pro Shop at JCKSC from 7:00 a.m. on the day of play. Proper and valid identification document, either Hong Kong Identity Card or Passport, must be produced when checking-in. No other identification proof would be accepted.

Competitors must check-in at least 30 minutes before their tee times and report to the starter **10 minutes** before their starting times.

5. Draw & Start Times

A draw will be made and a list of start times will be available a couple of days prior to the tournament at the JCKSC website: www.kscgolf.org.hk/golf/tournaments/

6. Practice Round

There will be no practice rounds for this event but players may arrange their own tee times, at their own expenses, prior to the day of play, via the normal telephone booking system.

7. Practice Balls

One complimentary basket of range balls will be made available to competitors on the day of the tournament. The driving range is open from 7:00 a.m.

8. **Prizes**

Trophies will be awarded to the winner, 2nd place and 3rd place of each division. In addition, best gross score, longest drive and nearest to the pin prizes are on offer.

9. **Prize Presentation**

Prize presentation and lunch will be arranged after the close of play, subject to the status of Covid-19.

10. **Scorecard Submission**

The Golf Course will submit completed scorecards to the HKGA after the tournament for the purpose of updating handicap index.

11. **Equipment and Valuables**

Daily lockers and bag storage are available. However, it is not advisable to leave valuables in golf bags. The course will take every care, but will not be held responsible for any loss or damage.

12. **Dress Code**

It is the responsibility of each player to be aware of and abide by, the dress code for JCKSC. A copy of this will be posted on the information board at the administration building. Both on and off the course and in the administration building, players should observe reasonable, inoffensive manner of dress allowing for tropical conditions.

In general however, the following rules should be observed.

- Denim wear including jeans, is not permitted
- Swimwear and athletic attire including tracksuits, shorts, T-shirts and sports shoes are not allowed.
- Shirts should be collared and worn inside trousers / shorts / skirts.
- Shorts should be tailored and of a conservative length.
- Footwear should be worn at all times, not changed in public areas and notice taken of rules regarding spike shoes.
