

JCKSC New Year Pairs Trophy 2023

**The Jockey Club Kau Sai Chau Public Golf Course – North Course
Sunday, 8 January 2023**

Information for Competitors

1. Venue and Date

JCKSC New Year Pairs Trophy 2023 will be played on Sunday, 8 January 2023 at The Jockey Club Kau Sai Chau Public Golf Course – North Course.

2. Entries / Entry Fee

The entry fee for the tournament is HK\$2,080.00 per PAIR

The entry forms can be obtained from the JCKSC website: www.kscgolf.org.hk under “Tournaments” section. Simply fill in the entry form and indicate your payment by way of a charge card providing detailed information and your authorized signature. You can return the completed entry form by email: tournament@kscgolf.org.hk or hand in to the JCKSC Administration Building. (Attention to: **Tournament Committee**)

A copy of a current handicap certificate or proof of handicap (**issued and updated on or after 8 July 2022**) must be accompanied with each entry form. A player’s handicap is his/her official handicap on the first day of the entry closing month, **i.e. 1 December 2022**. Priority will be given to teams with the lower combined handicap.

Entries closing date: Thursday, 22 December 2022 (6 p.m.)

The Tournament Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry without giving reasons or disqualify any competitor making a false statement on the entry form. All disputes and matters arising in connection with the Championships shall be referred to the Tournament Committee, whose decision shall be final.

3. Withdrawal Policy

The rules for cancellation are as follows:

- Prior to the entries closing date by 6:00 p.m. in writing or fax only – no penalty.
- After 6:00 p.m. of the entries closing date in writing or fax only – 50% of the entry fees will be forfeited as administration charge under any circumstances.
- Any cancellation on the tournament day, NO refund.

4. Registration

All competitors must register at the tournament check-in counter at JCKSC from 7:00am on the day of play. Proper and valid identification document, either Hong Kong Identity Card or Passport, must be produced when checking-in. No other identification proof would be accepted.

Competitors must check-in at least 30 minutes before their tee times and report to the starter **10 minutes** before their starting times.

5. Draw & Start Times

A draw will be made and a list of start times will be available a couple of days prior to the tournament at the JCKSC website: www.kscgolf.org.hk under Golf Tournaments section.

6. Practice Round

There will be no practice round for this event but players may arrange their own tee times, at their own expenses, prior to the day of play, via the normal telephone booking system.

7. Practice Balls

One complimentary basket of range balls will be made available to competitors on the day of the Tournament. The driving range is opened from 7:00 a.m.

8. Prizes

Prizes will be awarded from the winning PAIR to 4th position. In addition, longest drive and nearest to the pin prizes are on offer.

9. Prize Presentation

Prize presentation and lunch will be arranged after the close of play, subject to the status of Covid-19.

10. Scorecard Submission

The Golf Course will submit completed scorecards to the HKGA after the tournament for the purpose of updating handicap index.

11. Equipment and Valuables

Daily lockers and bag storage are available. However, it is not advisable to leave valuables in golf bags. The Golf Course will take every care, but will not be held responsible for any loss or damage.

12. Dress Code

It is the responsibility of each player to be aware of and abide by, the dress code for JCKSC. A copy of this will be posted on the Information Board at the Administration Building. Both on and off the course and in the Administration Building, players should observe a reasonable, inoffensive manner of dress allowing for tropical conditions.

In general, the following rules should be observed:

- i) Denim wear including jeans, is **not permitted**
- ii) Swimwear and athletic attire including tracksuits, shorts, T-shirts and sports shoes are **not allowed**.
- iii) Shirts should be collared and worn inside trousers / shorts / skirts.
- iv) Shorts should be tailored and of a conservative length.
- v) Footwear should be worn at all times and not changed in public areas.
