

JCKSC Parent & Child Cup Series 2023

The Jockey Club Kau Sai Chau Public Golf Course - North Course 18 February, 15 April & 3 June 2023 (Saturday)

Information for Competitors

1. Venue and Dates

JCKSC Parent and Child Cup Series 2023 to be played 9-hole on 18 February 2023, 15 April 2023 and 3 June 2023 (Saturday) at the Jockey Club Kau Sai Chau Public Golf Course - North Course.

2. <u>Entries / Entry Fee</u>

The entry fee for each round is HK\$1,000 per team. (Child must be under 21 years of age on the event days)

The entry form can be obtained from the JCKSC website: <u>https://www.kscgolf.org.hk/golf/tournaments/</u> Simply fill in the entry form and indicate your payment by way of a charge credit card providing detailed information and your authorized signature or by cheque (in Hong Kong Dollar only, crossed and make payable to "The Jockey Club Kau Sai Chau Public Golf Course Limited"), you can email the entry form to <u>tournament@kscgolf.org.hk</u> or return it to P.O. Box 88, Sai Kung Post Office, Sai Kung, Hong Kong. (Attention to: Tournament Committee)

A copy of a current handicap certificate or proof of handicap <u>(issued and updated in 6 months prior to the</u> <u>event date)</u> or <u>JCKSC Golf Pass Certificate</u> must be accompanied with each entry form.

Entries closing dates:

Competition	Event Dates	Entries Closing Dates
1	Saturday, 18 February 2023	6 p.m. on Friday, 3 February 2023 or when it is full
2	Saturday, 15 April 2023	6 p.m. on Friday, 31 March 2023 or when it is full
3	Saturday, 3 June 2023	6 p.m. on Friday, 19 May 2023 or when it is full

The Tournament Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry without giving reasons or disqualify any competitor making a false statement on the entry form. All disputes and matters arising in connection with the Championships shall be referred to the Tournament Committee, whose decision shall be final.

3. <u>Withdrawal Policy</u>

The rules for cancellation are as follows:

- a) Prior to the entries closing date by 6:00 p.m. in writing or fax only no penalty.
- b) After 6:00 p.m. of the entries closing date in writing or fax only 50% of the entry fees will be forfeited as administration charge under any circumstances.
- c) Any cancellation on the tournament day, NO refund

4. <u>Registration</u>

All competitors must register at the Instruction Centre from 1 p.m. on the day of play. Competitors must check-in at least 30 minutes before their tee times and report to the starter **10 minutes** before their starting times.

5. Draw & Start Times

A draw will be made and a list of start times will be available a couple of days prior to the tournament at the JCKSC website: <u>https://www.kscgolf.org.hk/golf/tournaments/</u>

6. Practice Round

There will be no practice round for this event but competitors may arrange their own tee times, at their own expenses, prior to the day of play, via the normal telephone booking system.

7. Practice Balls

One complimentary basket of range balls per person will be made available to competitors at the Driving Range on the day of the competition from around 1:30 p.m.

8. <u>Prizes</u>

Prizes will be awarded to the winning two-ball best ball stroke-play team and second position of each competition. Each team must participate at least two competitions to contend the Overall Champion and 2^{nd} Place.

Additionally, there will be a winner and second position team prize for the best two of the three combined stroke scores over the three tournament series. If a team plays all three competitions, they will have the opportunity to eliminate their worst stroke score from the three competitions.

E.g. A team participates in all three competitions with their two-ball best ball stroke scores of 45, 51 and 43. They would eliminate their score of 51 and keep 45 and 43, for a total of 88 strokes. However, if a team plays two competitions, they would need to keep both scores regardless. Also, if a team only participates in one competition, they would only be eligible for that particular competition which has team prizes per event.

9. Prize Presentation and Buffet Dinner

Prize presentation and dinner will be arranged after the close of play, subject to the status of Covid-19. In addition, the Overall Champion and 2^{nd} place will be awarded at the final competition on Saturday 3 June 2023.

10. Equipment and Valuables

Daily lockers and bag storage are available. However, it is not advisable to leave valuables in golf bags. The Golf Course will take every care, but will not be held responsible for any loss or damage.

11. Dress Code

It is the responsibility of each player to be aware of and abide by, the dress code for JCKSC. A copy of this will be posted on the Information Board at the Administration Building. Both on and off the course and in the Administration Building, players should observe a reasonable, inoffensive manner of dress allowing for tropical conditions.

In general, the following rules should be observed:

- a) Denim wear including jeans, is **not permitted**
- b) Swimwear and athletic attire including tracksuits, shorts, T-shirts and sports shoes are **not allowed**.
- c) Shirts should be collared and worn inside trousers / shorts / skirts.
- d) Shorts should be tailored and of a conservative length.
- e) Footwear should be worn at all times and not changed in public areas.
